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SMALL FEBRUARY WORKING FORCE MANS NATION'S FARMS

The number of workers on the Nation's farms in late February was the smallest in over 50 years of record. The total of 4,991,000 persons working in the survey week of February 17-23 was 3 percent less than a year earlier, and 10 percent under the 5-year average for the month.

Farm family members numbered 3,986,000. This was 3 percent below a year earlier. The estimated number of hired workers in the February survey week, 1,005,000, was 3 percent below February 1962. The hired worker totals represented a seasonal increase over January, reflecting farm work progress in southern and western areas.

February's Work Pace Looks Ahead to Spring

In many sections of the country the winter brought some of the coldest weather in nearly 30 years. Under these conditions livestock care and chores came first and preparations for early spring work next. February comments from many dairy farmers stressed the dwindling stores of hay and the high cost of feeding until new forage comes. Between chores and such other work as could be done there was some opportunity for what one Virginia observer called "fireside farming," keeping farm records, pondering costs, and making firmer plans for crop work, inspired by an occasional look at a colorful seed catalog.

Florida, California, and parts of Texas and Arizona showed the largest increases in crop work during February. The harvest of Florida early and mid-season oranges was nearly completed and harvest of Valencias started. Vegetable harvest gained and cutting of sugarcane was active. In the lower valley of Texas, cotton planting started after February 1, following a rough winter which damaged citrus and ornamentals. By the end of the month cotton and sorghums were being planted in the Coastal Bend area. Watermelon and cantaloupe acreage frozen out was replanted around Falfurrias and other centers.

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Washington, D. C.

In Arizona, cotton picking was virtually completed in February, and planting of 1963 cotton made a slow start. Lettuce harvest was active around Yuma and was well started in the Salt River Valley. Valencia orange harvest started well, and grapefruit harvest continued.

California had above-normal warmth during much of February, and thousands of acres of the State's fruits and almonds bloomed 1 to 2 weeks earlier than last year. Asparagus cutting was increasing in different areas in the State. In the irrigated desert Imperial Valley, cabbage and lettuce harvests were active, and first cutting of alfalfa hay was being cured. Navel orange harvest was about finished in the San Joaquin Valley and was increasing in Southern California.

Much of Oregon and Washington had considerable mild weather in February, and farm work was up to schedule or ahead. Spraying, pruning, and orchard clean-up moved rapidly. Washington caneberry growers had nearly finished pruning and tying canes.

The Mountain region had generally mild weather in February. The sunny days were especially favorable for early calving and lambing, which made considerable progress in these important livestock States. But while the new calves and lambs in the warm west frolicked in a wonderful world, ranchers viewed the scant or missing mountain snow-packs with apprehension of shortage of irrigation water.

Throughout the Central and Northeastern sections of the Nation, February work was near the year's slowest pace and mainly limited to livestock chores. Even maple tapping in New England and other parts of the Northeast waited for less wintry weather.
