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Noncitrus Fruits and Nuts 1996 Summary



Noncitrus Utilized Production Down 2 Percent, Value Up 4 Percent

The Nation's utilized production of the leading noncitrus fruit crops totaled 16.0 million tons in 1996, down 2 percent from 1995. Utilized 1996 production decreased from 1995 for apples, avocados, berries, cherries, figs, grapes, kiwifruit, papayas, peaches, and pears. Prunes and plums produced outside of California also declined. Utilized production increased for apricots, cranberries, dates, nectarines, olives, pineapples, California plums, California prunes, and strawberries. Banana and guava production did not change.

Value of utilized production for noncitrus fruit crops totaled \$7.12 billion, up 4 percent from 1995. Cranberry value will be published August 19, 1997, and was estimated for this report by multiplying season average prices for 1995 by the 1996 production.

Highlights

Utilized apple production for 1996 was estimated at 10.3 billion pounds, 1 percent less than 1995 and 9 percent below 1994. A 16 percent increase in apple production in Washington and a 6 percent increase in California were not enough to offset drops in the other States. Quality was excellent in Washington, but fruit size was generally smaller than a year ago. In Michigan, poor sizing resulted from near drought conditions in August 1996.

Utilized grape production for 1996 totaled 5.53 million tons, down 6 percent from 1995 and 1994 levels. California production declined 4 percent from last year. California table type showed the biggest decrease at 16 percent from a year ago, and wine and raisin types decreased 2 and 3 percent, respectively. Michigan and Washington production decreased, but New York and Pennsylvania increased from a year ago.

Utilized peach production was set at 2.01 billion pounds, down 8 percent from last year and 15 percent below 1994. The California crop, accounting for 83 percent of the U.S. peach crop, was up from 60 percent in 1995. Freeze damage totally destroyed the crop in Oklahoma and contributed to Georgia and South Carolina growers getting less than 10 percent of their 1995 crop.

Utilized pear production was placed at 820,250 tons, down 13 percent from 1995. Of the major pear-producing states, California was up 19 percent from last year, but Oregon was down 24 percent and Washington was down 29 percent.

Nut Production Increases 2 Percent, Value Down 4 Percent

The 1996 U.S. nut production (in-shell basis) increased 2 percent to 830,600 tons. California almond production totaled 510 million meat pounds, 38 percent above the 1995 total. Hawaii macadamia nut production climbed to a record high 56.5 million pounds, up 11 percent from the previous year. California walnut production decreased 11 percent to 208,000 tons. California pistachio production was estimated at 105 million pounds, a decrease of 29 percent from a year ago. U.S. pecan production fell to 222 million pounds, down 17 percent from last year. Hazelnut production totaled 19,000 tons, less than half of 1995's output, and the smallest crop since 1989.

The 1996 value of utilized production for all the nut crops totaled \$1.65 billion, down 4 percent from last year. Value of almond production was a record high \$1.01 billion. Value of macadamia nuts, at \$44.1 million, was the second largest ever. The value of the walnut crop was \$322 million, down 2 percent from 1995. Values were substantially lower for pistachios, pecans, and hazelnuts.
