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Grain Report for 1/21/2022 - Final

Compared to the last report: Premiums are steady with moderate demand. According to the US Drought Monitor January 20 2022 a winter storm impacted areas from the northern Plains, to the Midwest, into the Southeast and then up the east coast during the period. For many areas, this was the first time that heavy snow occurred in these regions as many have brought up "snow drought" in areas of the country where snow has been minimal. From the Missouri River west, there was very little precipitation for the week. Temperatures were warmest over the northern Rocky Mountains and Plains where departures were 10-15 degrees above normal. Cooler temperatures dominated the East as departures were 5-10 degrees below normal. The next available report will be Friday, January 28, 2022.
