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Grain Report for 2/17/2023 - Final

Compared to the last report: Premiums were good with moderate demand. Growers show more willingness to sell. According to the US Drought monitor on February16, 2023 an active weather week over much of the South, Southeast and portions of the Midwest allowed many locations in eastern Oklahoma, northern Arkansas, central Mississippi, northern Florida, southern Georgia and into coastal areas of South Carolina to record above-normal precipitation. Dry conditions dominated the West and northern Plains. Temperatures were well above normal in the northern Plains and upper Midwest, with departures of 15-20 degrees above normal. Most areas east of the Missouri River were above normal for the week with departures of 5-15 degrees above normal common. Cooler-than-normal temperatures dominated the intermountain West and into the Four Corners region where temperatures were5-10 degrees below normal for the week. The next available Non GMO/GE report will be February 24, 2023.
